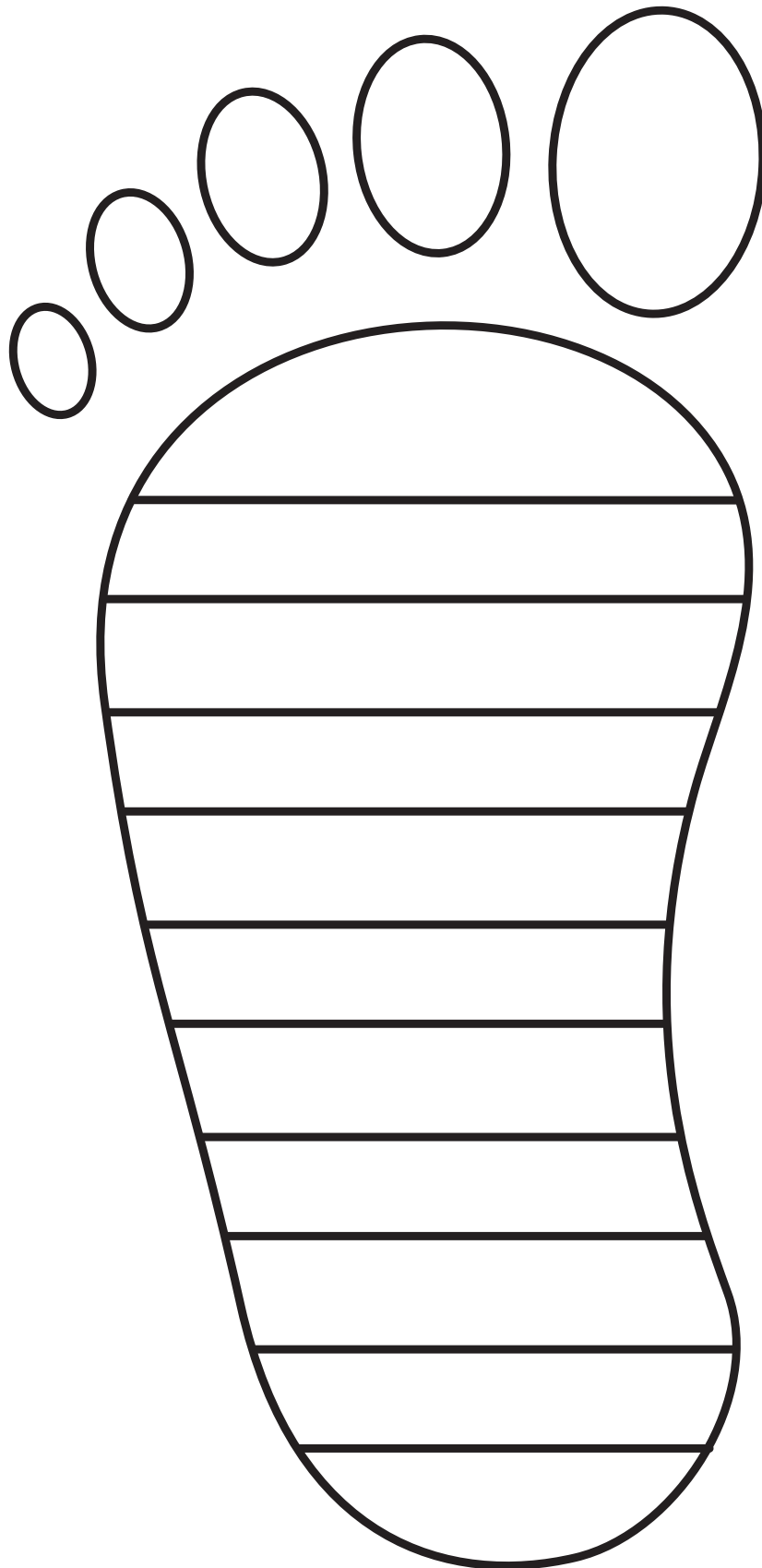

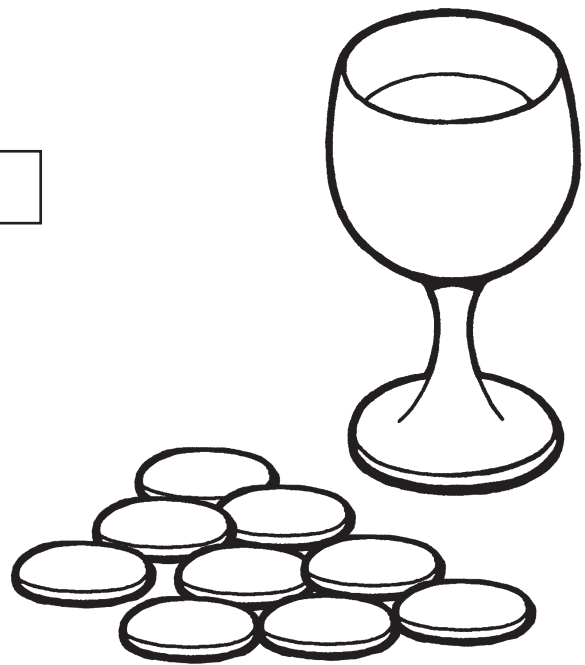

Jesus taught us that we can show love for him by _____⁴ others.

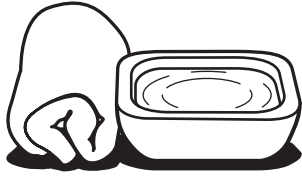

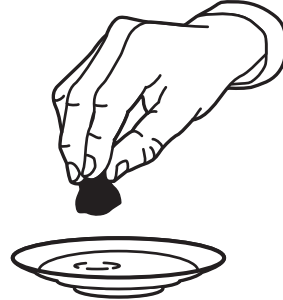

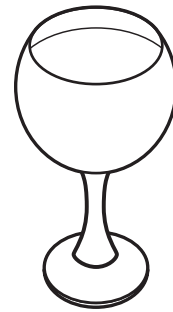
